## DRIVES, HARDSTANDING AND GARDEN DECKING

Certain limited forms of development can be undertaken without the need to make a planning application to the local planning authority, these are know as <u>Permitted Development Rights</u> and are granted under the terms of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order. Please note that flats and mobile homes do <u>not</u> benefit from Permitted Development Rights.

**Important:** Please contact the Planning Department if the property is within the curtilage of a <u>Listed Building</u>, <u>Conservation Area</u> or if you suspect that it is possible the property has had its <u>Permitted Development Rights removed</u> as further restrictions to those listed in this form are likely.

Please answer the following questions in the section relevant to your proposal to determine if planning permission is required.




