New Longton / Whitestake Walk approx 2.5 miles

This is a fairly gentle walk of 2.5 miles. The walk should take approximately 60 - 75 mins.

The walk is on flat ground on tarmac footpaths and roads with no inclines. **SPECIAL CARE** should be taken on sections of roads in the countryside where there is no footpath to walk on.

- Start the walk from the car park at New Longton Sports & Social Club on Chapel Lane, New Longton.
- From the car park, cross the road, walk past the pharmacy and follow the road around until it becomes Station Road.
- Proceed down Station Road until you reach the junction of Wham Lane and Hugh Barn Road.
- Cross over the road, taking care, proceed down Sheep Hill Lane until its end.
- Turn left onto Long Moss Lane, follow the road until you reach a sharp bend.
- At the bend carry straight on along Startley Nook keeping Coxhead's Nursery to your right, stay on this road until its end where it re-joins Long Moss Lane.
- Turn right onto Long Moss Lane and follow it to its end at Chain House Lane.
- Take a sharp left, proceed a short distance along Chain House Lane until you reach the start of Pope Lane, where you need to cross the road.
- Proceed along Pope Lane until you reach Cage Lane.
- 9 Turn left onto Cage Lane and follow it to its end.
- Turn right onto Royalty Lane and follow it around until you reach Balmoral Road.
- Turn right onto Balmoral Road and walk a short distance along it until you reach Windsor Avenue.
- Walk to the end of Windsor Avenue then follow the footpath that takes you behind New Longton Bowling Club and onto The Cedars.
- Proceed along The Cedars to its junction with Station Road turning right which will bring you back to the car park where you started.
