

WHICH BIN DO I USE?

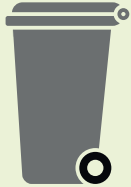


All items should be placed loose inside the blue bin and green box.

DOs & DON'Ts



GREY BIN

- ✔ NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE, PLASTIC PACKAGING, FOOD WASTE
- ✘ PAINT, OIL, BUILDING WASTE



BROWN BIN

- ✔ GRASS CUTTINGS, HEDGE CUTTINGS, PRUNINGS, DEAD FLOWERS, HOUSE PLANTS, CUT FLOWERS, LEAVES, WEEDS
- ✘ FOOD WASTE, CARDBOARD, SOIL, BUILDING WASTE



BLUE BIN

- ✔ PLASTIC BOTTLES, GLASS BOTTLES, GLASS JARS, FOOD CANS, DRINKS CANS, AEROSOLS, CLEAN TIN FOIL.
- ✘ PAINT, OIL, BUILDING WASTE



GREEN BOX

- ✔ NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, CARDBOARD PACKAGING, BROWN CARD, DIRECTORIES, CATALOGUES, JUNK MAIL, ENVELOPES
- ✘ TETRAPAKS, WALLPAPER
